
#### **ABOUT THE HOST**

After graduating from Mississippi State University and Ole Miss Law School, John Grisham began a career in law in 1981 in Southaven, MS. In 1983, Grisham was elected to serve in the Mississippi Legislature. It was during these years that he began work on his first novel, *A Time to Kill*. He has since written twenty-four additional novels, all of which have been international best sellers.

Grisham dedicated himself to the rebuilding of the Mississippi Gulf Coast following Hurricane Katrina. Through the Rebuild the Coast Foundation, started by Grisham and his wife Renee with their seed money of \$5 million, the Coast has received \$8.8 million in funds to help restore it to the thriving community it was.

“Our goal was to create a fund that we knew would directly help as many people as possible as quickly as possible,” says Grisham. “That the fund was able to...bring some relief to so many people on the Coast truly exceeded our expectations.”

Grisham and Bobby Moak became close friends when they served along side each other in the state legislature. Both realized they had a belief in a strong future for Mississippi and its people. Believe PAC carries on those ideals.
